Place and Travelling

The venue for the AIC2023 is the Riverie by Katathani, Chiang Rai. How to travel to Chiang Rai from abroad? The international flight will land at Suvarnabhumi Airport. Three airlines can bring you from Suvarnabhumi Airport to Chiang Rai Airport: <u>Thai Smile Airway</u>, <u>Thai Viet Jet Airline</u> and <u>Thai Airway</u>. If you buy a transfer flight at Suvarnabhumi airport, do not go the passport control, but follow the sign "Transfer to Chiangmai Chiangrai".

At the Chiang Rai airport, we will provide a transfer to the hotel (any hotel you book). Letters of invitation that help to get a VISA will be sent to participants who need them by the 30th of June.




New Colour Book: The Art of Colour: The History of Art in 39 Pigments, by Kelly Grovier
